On behalf of Sweden, Mr Berglund thanked the organisers for their efforts to shed light on the fate of Dag Hammarskjöld. Sweden has been leading the efforts to reestablish the Hammarskjöld investigation through resolutions in the UN General Assembly. Mr Berglund described how the Swedish special investigator, Ambassador Mathias Mossberg, had been given unprecedented access to archives, including from the Swedish intelligence services. Mr Berglund encouraged all the relevant countries, who had not yet appointed national investigators, to do so.
